**SH 1932-1935**

Pilot Officer, RAFVR, 61 Squadron Bomber Command.  
Killed when his Hampden crashed while trying to land at RAF Upwood on returning from a raid on Cologne.  
Buried Brookwood Military Cemetery.  
31/7/1941 aged 24 years.

### **Albrecht JMB**

**H 1933-1935**

Flight Sergeant, RAF, 102 Squadron Bomber Command.  
Killed when his Halifax was shot down by a night-fighter over Luxembourg on an operation to Frankfurt.  
Buried Florennes Communal Cemetery, Namur.  
3/12/1942 aged 23 years.

### **Alexander JS**

**L 1933-1938**

Lieutenant, 2nd Battalion Cheshire Regiment.  
Killed while guiding his transport out of a minefield, shortly after the conclusion of the Battle of El Alamein.  
Buried El Alamein War Cemetery.  
13/11/1942 aged 22 years.

### **Allardice DW**

**S 1927-1931**

Lieutenant, 8th (Irish) Battalion King's Regiment (Liverpool), attached 8<sup>th</sup> Battalion Durham Light Infantry.  
Killed in action in the Western Desert.  
Buried El Alamein War Cemetery.  
2/11/1942 aged 29 years.

### **Allardice PMcL**

**S 1931-1935**

Pilot Officer, RAFVR, 185 Squadron Mediterranean Theatre.  
Killed in action over the Mediterranean in the vicinity of Malta while flying a Hurricane (G).  
Remembered on the Malta Memorial.  
22/3/1942 aged 24 years.

### **Arkle JNP**

**SH 1936-1939**

Flight Lieutenant, RAFVR, 263 Squadron Tactical Air Force.  
**His Typhoon was hit by flak near Heinsberg, crash-landed near Geilenkirchen on 18/11/44, and he was later shot by his captors.**  
Buried Susteren Roman Catholic Churchyard, Limburg, Netherlands.  
26/11/1944 aged 22 years.

### **Armitstead J**

**E 1938-1941**

Aircraftman First Class (pilot under training), RAFVR.  
Killed on active service when his aircraft crashed during his course under the Empire Training Scheme in South Africa.  
Buried Vereeniging Old Town Cemetery, Gauteng, SA.  
25/5/1945 aged 20 years.

Captain, 11th Armoured Division, Signals.

Killed in action at Celle, Germany and first buried at Huxhal.

Buried Becklingen War Cemetery, Soltau, Germany.

15/4/1945 aged 24 years.

**Benson NJV**

**P 1934-1937**

Pilot Officer, RAF, 603 Squadron Fighter Command.

His Spitfire was shot down by Messerschmitts over Tenterden in Kent while on patrol during the Battle of Britain.

Buried Great Ouseburn Churchyard, Yorkshire.

28/8/1940 aged 21 years.

**Bleasby GR**

**E 1935-1938**

Sub-Lieutenant, RNVR, Fleet Air Arm 830 Squadron, HMS Furious.

Killed in a mid-air collision over the Clyde in a Fairey Barracuda aircraft while on a training exercise.

Remembered on the Lee-on-Solent Memorial.

15/11/1943 aged 22 years.

**Bradley KR**

**P 1931-1935**

Captain, 2nd Battalion East Surrey Regiment.

Killed in action near the Muda River during the retreat from Gurun, North Malaya.

Remembered on the Singapore Memorial.

17/12/1941 aged 22 years.

**Breare JB**

**W 1935-1937**

Flight Engineer, RAFVR, 101 Squadron Bomber Command.

His Lancaster collided with another during an operation to Ludwigshafen.

Buried Choloy War Cemetery, Moselle.

1/2/1945 aged 24 years.

**Brearley GM**

**H 1935-1940**

Pilot Officer (Observer), RAFVR, 85 Squadron Fighter Command.

Killed when the wings of his Havoc aircraft (AH444) came off during a dive off the Essex coast. P/O GM Brearley was the equipment operator of a 85 Sqd Havoc taking part in an air-to-air firing exercise on 6.8.42, piloted by P/O HM Kiernan. During a steep dive the starboard wing broke off and the port wing crumpled up. The aircraft crashed into the sea 200 yards off Clacton, Essex.

Remembered on the Brookwood Memorial.

6/8/1942 aged 20 years.

**Brown PAL**

**L 1926-1930**

Captain, Assam Regiment.

Died of wounds sustained at Jail Hill during the battle for Kohima, which began on 4th April.  
Buried Kohima War Cemetery, Assam.  
6/4/1944 aged 32 years.

**Brown WA**

**L 1934-1939**

Second Lieutenant, Royal Signals.  
Died on active service in a motor cycle accident.  
Buried Denton Cemetery, Lancashire.  
15/10/1941 aged 21 years.

**Bruce ACA**

**L 1928-1933**

Major, [Bimbashi – delete]Sudan Defence Force.  
Killed in action against the Italians near Agordat in Eritrea.  
Buried Keren War Cemetery, Eritrea. Sedbergh School is mentioned  
on his gravestone.  
27/1/1941 aged 26 years.

**Bryham PW**

**E 1935-1940**

Lieutenant, 18th Royal Garhwal Rifles.  
Killed in action in Singapore on the day of its surrender.  
Remembered on the Singapore Memorial.  
15/2/1942 aged 21 years.

**Buckley L**

**L 1902-1902**

Major, Royal Army Medical Corps.  
Died when his house was hit in a daylight bombing raid at Stanmore, Middlesex.  
Buried Wincanton Cemetery, Somerset. (Fought 1914-18).  
13/10/1940 aged 54 years.

**Bushell JR, DFM**

**H 1922-1926**

Pilot Officer (Air Gunner), RAFVR, 15 Squadron Bomber Command.  
Killed when his Stirling was hit by anti-aircraft fire when bombing Dunkirk.  
Buried Dunkirk Town Cemetery.  
19/7/1941 aged 33 years.

**Calvert JL**

**SH 1931-1934**

Pilot Officer, RAF, Advance Air Striking Force, 150 Squadron  
Bomber Command.  
Died of wounds after his Fairey Battle aircraft crashed while on a photographic  
sortie over Ecury-sur-Coole, Marne, France.  
Buried Clichy Northern Cemetery, north of Paris.  
20/9/1939 aged 22 years.  
Earliest OS casualty in the War.

**Campbell JC, VC, DSO (Bar), MC('14-'18)**

**E 1907-1912**

Major General, Royal Horse Artillery.  
Killed in a staff car accident near Bug-Bug east of Tobruk.  
Buried Cairo War Cemetery. (Won VC at Sidi Rezegh 21/11/41)  
26/02/1942 aged 48 years.

<p><b>Cavaghan H</b>            Private, 6th Battalion Border Regiment, attached 7th Hampshires.            Killed in action at Hill 112 during the Normandy campaign.            Buried Hottot-les-Bagues War Cemetery, Calvados, France.            1/8/1944 aged 19 years.</p>	<p><b>L 1939-1943</b></p>
<p><b>Chesman JH</b>            Sergeant Pilot, RAFVR, 55 Squadron Bomber Command.            Killed when his Blenheim crashed in the Egyptian Desert while returning from an attack on Crete.            Buried El Alamein War Cemetery.            27/5/1941 aged 25 years.</p>	<p><b>E 1929-1933</b></p>
<p><b>Churchill WM, DSO, DFC,</b>            Group Captain (Pilot), RAF 605 Squadron Fighter Command, Middle East.            Killed when his Spitfire was hit by anti-aircraft fire during an attack on Comiso airfield, Sicily. Immediately before his death he had played a leading role in the relief of Malta in command of 38 Spitfires brought from England on HMS Furious in <i>Operation Pedestal</i>.            Buried Syracuse War Cemetery, Sicily.            27/8/1942 aged 35 years.</p>	<p><b>SH 1921-1926</b></p>

**Cockin PM**

**SH 1931-1934**

Second Lieutenant, East Yorkshire Yeomanry, 23rd Anti-Tank Battery.  
Killed during a 'friendly fire' incident at Watou, Belgium, while with the British Expeditionary Force.  
Remembered on the Dunkirk Memorial.  
18/5/1940 aged 23 years.

**Cooper P**

**S 1934-1937**

Lieutenant, 582 Field Company Royal Engineers.  
Killed by shellfire while working on construction of a floating boom to protect piers of a road bridge over the Waal at Nijmwegen.  
Buried Jonkerbos War Cemetery, Netherlands.  
2/10/1944 aged 25 years.

**Crombie DFC**

**SH 1931-1936**

Second Lieutenant, 322 Battery, 103 Heavy Anti-Aircraft Regiment, RA.  
Died of natural causes on active service. (Four days before due to be retired on grounds of ill-health)  
Buried Beith New Cemetery, Ayrshire.  
23/3/1942 aged 24 years.

**Dahl CT**

**H 1903-1906**

Second Engineer, Merchant Navy. (Fought in Royal Navy 1914-18).  
Lost at sea, aboard SS Alnmoor, which was sunk while on a convoy from Halifax, Nova Scotia, to Glasgow.  
Remembered on the Tower Hill Memorial, London.  
15/2/1941 aged 51 years.

**Daniel CT**

**L 1931-1933**

Sergeant (Wireless Operator/Gunner), RAFVR, 172 Squadron Coastal Command.  
Killed in an air accident in a Wellington aircraft (2872).  
Buried Heanton Punchardon Churchyard, Devon.  
13/04/1942 aged 26 years.

**Date DW**

**P1928-1932**

Pilot Officer, RAFVR, 59 Squadron Coastal Command.  
Pilot of a Blenheim, shot down north of Den Haag, while on an anti-shipping patrol from RAF Bircham Newton.  
Remembered on the Runnymede Memorial.  
22/3/1941 aged 26 years.

**Dawson WW**

**E 1934-1938**

Flight Sergeant (Navigator), RAFVR, 61 Squadron Bomber Command.  
Killed when his Lancaster was shot down by a night-fighter over Belgium on an

operation to Plzen (Pilsen), Czechoslovakia. It was his 28th operational sortie.  
Buried Chièvres Communal Cemetery, Belgium.  
17/4/1943 aged 22 years.

**Dean JR**

**W 1937-1941**

Sub-Lieutenant, RNVR, HM Motor Torpedo Boat 667. Mentioned in Despatches.  
Drowned on active service.  
Remembered on the Portsmouth Naval Memorial.  
26/7/1944 aged 21 years.

**Dent RCW**

**H 1922-1926**

Major, 2/12 Burma Frontier Force.  
Died at sea following the sinking of the SS Rooseboom en route from Padang to Colombo.  
Remembered on the Singapore Memorial.  
4/3/1942 aged 34 years.

**Dey DH**

**L 1928-1932**

Flight Lieutenant, RAFVR, Flying Training Command, RAF Evanton.  
Killed in a flying accident when his Blackburn Botha crashed in poor visibility into Dalbeoch Wood, near Evanton .  
Buried Kiltearn, Ross & Cromarty.  
6/10/1941 aged 27 years.

**Dorman SL**

**SH 1930-1935**

Major, 1<sup>st</sup> Parachute Squadron Royal Engineers.  
Killed in action (ambushed) while leading a mixed/infantry reconnaissance patrol to locate a German tank-harbour) 15 miles north East of Beja and west of Mateur, Tunisia.  
Buried Medjez-el-Bab War Cemetery, Tunisia.  
18/12/1942 aged 26 years.

**Dorward TF**

**SH 1930-1933**

Pilot Officer, RAFVR, 25 Squadron Fighter Command.  
Killed on active service while flying in a Blenheim aircraft over Leicestershire.  
Buried Eastlands Cemetery, Galashiels, Scotland.  
5/3/1941 aged 24 years.

**Douglas JB**

**E 1922-1925**

Private, Infantry, New Zealand Forces.  
Killed in action during the German attack on the allied force in northern Greece, which began on 6th April. He was serving with the Second New Zealand Expeditionary Force.  
Remembered on the Athens Memorial.  
18/5/1941 aged 32 years.

**Dryburgh NG**

**S 1919-1921**

Pilot Officer, RAFVR, 16 OTU, Bomber Command, Upper Heyford.  
Killed when his Hampden collided with another aircraft off the Devon Coast.  
Buried Edinburgh Dean Cemetery.  
27/5/1940 aged 38 years.

**Dun J****W 1932-1935**

Captain, 6th Battalion, King's Own Scottish Borderers.  
Killed in action near Evrecy, during the Normandy campaign.  
Buried Banneville-la-Campagne War Cemetery, Calvados.  
16/7/1944 aged 26 years.

**Edwards RH****E 1934-1938**

Flight Lieutenant, RAF, 142 Squadron Bomber Command.  
Mentioned in Despatches.

Shot down in a Fairey Battle aircraft on 29/7/1940 and died as PoW in Hospital in Poland.  
Buried Poznan Old Garrison Cemetery, Poland.  
26/9/1942 aged 22 years.

**Elder ADH****H 1938-1942**

Sub-Lieutenant, RNVR Fleet Air Arm, 846 Squadron, HMS Trumpeter  
Killed when his Grumman Avenger was shot down by anti-aircraft fire  
in an attack on Kilbotn U-boat base during *Operation Judgement*.  
Buried Sorvik Churchyard, Norway.  
4/5/1945 aged 20 years.

**Evans PB****P 1936-1941**

Captain, 141st (7th Battalion the Buffs [Royal East Kent]) Regiment,  
Royal Armoured Corps.  
Killed in action at Limburg.  
Buried Sittard War Cemetery, Limburg, Netherlands.  
21/11/1944 aged 21 years.

**Fairhurst JB****P 1929-1933**

Captain, Warwickshire Yeomanry, Royal Armoured Corps.  
Killed in action on the day of the British breakthrough at El Alamein.  
Buried El Alamein War Cemetery.  
2/11/1942 aged 26 years.

**Fawcett WL, MC ('14-'18)****SH 1908-1914**

Brigadier, General Staff (formerly with 2/9th Gurkha Rifles).  
Presumed lost at sea while on his way from Singapore to India to take up  
his appointment as Director of Military Operations there. However, later  
evidence suggests that his boat was wrecked on a small island where he and  
his companions were discovered by the Japanese and killed.  
Remembered on the Singapore Memorial.  
13/2/1942 aged 46 years.

**Forrest JN, DSO, DFC****L 1920-1924**

Squadron Leader, RAFVR, 97 Squadron Bomber Command.  
Killed when his Lancaster crashed in the vicinity of Döberitz on an operation  
to Berlin.  
Remembered on the Runnymede Memorial.  
24/8/1943 aged 36 years.

<p><b>Fulton JV</b>  Lieutenant-Commander, RNVR, Captain of frigate, HMS Goodall.  Killed when his ship was torpedoed and sunk by a U-boat off Kola inlet, Murmansk on the last Russian convoy before VE Day, (see also <b>RR Whyte</b>).  Remembered on the Chatham Naval Memorial.  29/4/1945 aged 36 years.</p>	<p><b>SH 1924-1927</b></p>

Lieutenant, Royal Army Medical Corps.

Buried Halfaya Sollum War Cemetery, Egypt.  
30/5/1941 aged 27 years.

**Grey JN**

**H 1935-1939**

Flying Officer, RAFVR, 6 Squadron Middle East Command.  
Killed in action while flying a Hurricane on a reconnaissance mission from Malta over the  
Podgorski Channel after attacking a ship.  
Remembered on the Malta Memorial.  
23/5/1944 aged 22 years.

**Gundill P**

**S 1931-1936**

Lieutenant, West Yorkshire Regiment.  
Killed in action during the Knightsbridge Battle  
(see also **ER Hanmer**).  
Buried Knightsbridge Cemetery, Acroma, Libya.  
5/6/1942 aged 25 years.

**Gunn GW, VC (Posthumous), MC**

**S 1926-1930**

Second Lieutenant, Royal Horse Artillery.  
Killed in the action at Sidi Rezegh for which he won the Victoria Cross.  
Buried Knightsbridge Cemetery, Libya.  
21/11/1941 aged 29 years.

**Gunn PM, MC**

**S 1929-1933**
